## **Matters Arising**

Basketball net – At the meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> November with the technician from Bradford Parks and Leisure, measurements were taken and a price agreed. Peter Merifield was unable to attend, to represent the police.

Older Children's Park – This was surveyed as part of the meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> November. Measurements were taken and a site for the space net was approved. A further site visit is needed to discuss the basket. It was agreed to keep the flat roundabout and the swings.

Princes Trust – Offered an ambassador to come to speak at one of the youth council meetings, but not necessarily Dawn Feather. Agreed it would be better to wait until Dawn can arrange a visit.

Finance – There was agreement for movement of monies between accounts in order to make necessary payments.

Siltden Majorettes – Cllr Tim Maddox attended with the vice president of the majorettes to put a case for a grant from the youth council towards expenses in 2009.

As the group has become more successful, their expenses have increased, as there is increased travelling and numbers to accommodate. It costs approx £400 per trip, which recently increased subs do not cover. An annual fundraising event held in Siltden needs funding prior to the event. The local town and city councils have been approached. Money is needed for hire of toilets and of the space for the event. Suggestions were made to reduce costs and a grant of £300 was agreed.

Remembrance Sunday - Cllr Bottomley thanked Danny, who laid the wreath on behalf of the youth council.
